

AUCKLAND HARBOUR CROSSING POLL June 2021

CLIENT: New Zealand Taxpayers' Union

POLL DATES: Mon 13 to Thu 17 June 2021. The median response was

collected on Tue 14 June 2021.

TARGET POPULATION: Eligible New Zealand voters.

SAMPLE POPULATION: Eligible New Zealand voters who are contactable on a landline

or mobile phone.

SAMPLE SIZE: 1,000 respondents agreed to participate.

SAMPLE SELECTION: A random selection of 18,000 nationwide phone numbers.

WEIGHTING: The results are weighted to reflect the overall voting adult

population in terms of gender, age, and area.

SAMPLE ERROR: Based on this sample of 1,000 respondents, the maximum

sampling error (for a result of 50%) is +/- 3.1%, at the 95%

confidence level.

CODE COMPLIANCE: This poll was conducted in accordance with the Research

Association New Zealand Code of Practice and the

International Chamber of Commerce/European Society for Opinion and Market Research Code on Market and Social

Research.



The Government has announced it plans to spend almost \$700 million on constructing a cycle and pedestrian bridge over Auckland Harbour. What is your view of this as a transport project? Is it strongly oppose, somewhat oppose, somewhat support or strongly support?

63% of New Zealanders are opposed to the Auckland Harbour cycle and pedestrian bridge and 18% support it, with net support (support less opposition) being -45%.

More than three times as many voters are opposed to the bridge as support it.

A majority (52%) state they are strongly opposed.

Net support by party vote is:

- 1. Green voters +6%
- 2. Labour voters -5%
- 3. Undecided voters -68%
- 4. National voters: -84%
- 5. ACT voters -94%

The only demographic in support is Green Party voters. Labour voters are mildly opposed, and National, ACT and undecided voters very strongly opposed.
