

SHAW TRAVEL POLL October 2021

- CLIENT:** New Zealand Taxpayers' Union
- POLL DATES:** Sun 03 to Mon 11 Oct 2021. The median response was collected on Wed 06 Oct 2021.
- TARGET POPULATION:** Eligible New Zealand voters.
- SAMPLE POPULATION:** Eligible New Zealand voters who are contactable on a landline or mobile phone.
- SAMPLE SIZE:** 1,000 respondents agreed to participate.
- SAMPLE SELECTION:** A random selection of 24,000 nationwide phone numbers.
- WEIGHTING:** The results are weighted to reflect the overall voting adult population in terms of gender, age, and area.
- SAMPLE ERROR:** Based on this sample of 1,000 respondents, the maximum sampling error (for a result of 50%) is +/- 3.1%, at the 95% confidence level.
- CODE COMPLIANCE:** This poll was conducted in accordance with the Research Association New Zealand Code of Practice and the International Chamber of Commerce/European Society for Opinion and Market Research Code on Market and Social Research.

Climate Change Minister James Shaw is planning to fly with 14 staff to a climate conference in Glasgow which currently has over 400 new Covid cases a day. Shaw and the nine staff members returning to New Zealand will take up ten spots in MIQ when they return. Do you think James Shaw should attend the climate conference in Glasgow?
