

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CIRCULATORS OF NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR BILL BRADY for ILLINOIS SENATE/44TH DISTRICT

1. Circulators must be 18 years of age or older, and citizens of the United States. Circulators need NOT have voted in a previous Republican primary.
2. All signers, but NOT circulators, MUST live and be registered to vote in the 44th Senate District.
3. Circulators MAY NOT circulate petitions for more than one political party at the same primary.
4. Circulators who are registered voters in the 44th Senate District MAY sign (as petition signers) on ONE page of the petitions which they may circulate.
5. Circulators may pass this petition only in the 44th Senate District. You may make copies of the blank petition on letter-sized paper.
6. Circulators must print their names and residence information on the petition and sign as the circulator of the petition in the presence of a Notary Public who will affix his/her seal or stamp to the petition. Most banks and libraries will notarize free of charge. "County of" below State of Illinois refers to county in which the petitions are notarized.
7. Petition pages with fewer than 15 names DO count. If a circulator cannot fill a petition, send in the partial page. Each name counts. Known bad signatures do not invalidate a petition sheet but should be brought to the attention of the campaign so they can be officially deleted. A circulator who routinely and recklessly disregards signature-gathering rules MAY have entire sheets of signatures stricken even though some signatures are valid.
8. DO NOT NUMBER THE PETITION PAGE. This will be completed when petitions are assembled by the campaign for filing.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SIGNERS OF NOMINATING PETITIONS

1. Petition signers MUST be registered voters in the 44th Senate District and MUST use the address at which they are registered to vote. Post Office boxes or business addresses are NOT acceptable.
2. Signers need not have voted in a previous Republican Primary Election.
3. Signers MAY NOT sign petitions for candidates of more than one political party at the same primary. Signers MAY sign petitions for more than one Republican candidate (e.g., a Republican for State Senate and a Republican for Congress).
4. All petition signers MUST sign in the presence and observation of the circulator. Petition signers may NOT sign the petition more than once.
5. Petition signers MUST sign for themselves only. They MAY NOT sign for spouses, family members or others, whether authorized or not.
6. Petition signers MUST sign their names as registered to vote (e.g. Sarah Jones is proper, Mrs. John Jones is not proper). Nicknames are NOT acceptable, (e.g. William E. Jones is proper, Bill Jones is not proper unless that is the way the signer is registered to vote). Printing their names also is NOT acceptable.
7. Signers must NOT use ditto marks for any part of an address.
