

NOMINATING PETITIONS – Circulators

- 1. Circulators MUST be 18 years of age or older and citizens of the United States.
- 2. Circulators MUST personally witness all signatures given.
- 3. Circulators MAY NOT circulate petitions for more than one political party (e.g., circulating a petition for a Republican for President and a Democrat for Congress is prohibited). Circulators MAY circulate petitions for more than one Republican candidate.
- 4. Circulators MUST personally appear and sign the circulator's oath and a notary seal stamped on the petition by a notary public licensed in Illinois. Most banks and public libraries will notarize a petition free of charge.
- 5. Blank spaces in the circulator's affidavit SHOULD be completed with the exception of the page number. DO NOT NUMBER THE PETITION SHEETS.

NOMINATING PETITIONS - Signers

- 1. For Presidential Preference petitions, signers must live and be registered to vote in the State of Illinois. For Delegate and Alternate Delegate petitions, signers must also live and be registered to vote in the congressional district for which they are signing.
- 2. Signers MAY NOT sign petitions for more than one political party (e.g., signing a petition for a Republican for President and a petition for a Democrat for Congress is prohibited). Signers MAY sign petitions for more than one Republican candidate.
- 3. Petition signers do not need to have voted in a previous Republican Primary to be eligible to sign the petition.
- 4. All petition signers MUST sign in the presence of the circulator.
- 5. Petition signers may NOT sign the petition more than once.
- 6. Petition signers MUST sign only for themselves. They MAY NOT sign for spouses, family members or others.
- 7. Petition signers SHOULD sign their names as listed on their voter's registration card. For example, "William E. Jones" not "Bill Jones".
- 8. The petition signers SHOULD SIGN AND NOT PRINT THEIR NAMES unless that is the way they signed their voter's registration card.
- 9. DO NOT use ditto ("") marks for any part of an address.
