






Seattle Consumer Price Index




Coalition COLA History




Coaltion COLA and Seattle Consumer Price Index




Seattle Employment Cost Index




Seattle CPI-W: Shelter Only




Housing Cost Data – Case Shiller Seattle Index




Housing Cost Data – Zillow (King County)



Housing Cost Data – Zillow (City of Seattle)










Total County Revenue Sources (Excluding Capital) Overall 4.12% Growth Between Bienniums




General Fund Revenue Sources (Excluding Capital) Overall 7.72% Growth Between Bienniums
