**POSITION SUMMARY:**

**Starting wage depending on qualifications (only returning seasonal employees are eligible for top steps).**

**This job posting will be used to fill multiple seasonal laborer openings within the Public Work Department as well as Parks, Culture & Recreation Department. Three immediate positions will be filled in January for the Public Works Department. Both departments anticipate filling additional positions, as needed, throughout the spring and summer months.**

**The departments will contact candidates who are to be scheduled for an interview. Upon successful completion of a departmental interview, a driving abilities assessment will be conducted prior to candidates being offered seasonal employment with the city.**

**Seasonal positions are hired for six months or less and are not eligible for health coverage.**

These are temporary positions (semi-skilled labor). Duties performed will vary depending on the department for which candidates are hired. Those assigned to the Parks, Culture & Recreation Department will assist with daily maintenance and clean-up of grounds and facilities. Those assigned to the Public Works Department will assist with construction, utilities, and/or street maintenance activities.

**EXAMPLES OF JOB DUTIES:**

**Parks, Culture & Recreation Department**

1. Responsible for daily maintenance and clean-up of grounds and facilities as well as other assigned areas.
2. Responsible for daily area set-up and preparations for normal operations and special events.
3. Assist with a variety of tasks requiring manual labor such as painting, hand digging, landscape installation and maintenance including hanging baskets, turf areas, trees, flower beds, and shrubbery in park facilities.
4. Use of standard hand tools (screw drivers, saws, hammers, shovel, pitch fork, rake, blowers, weed eaters, and walk behind mowers).
5. Performs other duties as assigned.

**Public Works Department**

1. Performs a variety of tasks requiring manual labor such as hand digging and pipe installation.

2. Use of standard hand tools (screw drivers, saws, hammers, shovel, pitch fork, rake, blowers, weed-eaters, and mowers).
3. Completes service requests as needed.
4. General maintenance and clean-up duties.
5. Performs other duties as assigned.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Must possess a valid Washington State Drivers' License.
- Must pass a driving abilities assessment.
- Ability to effectively operate equipment used in assigned department.
- Ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions.

**Parks, Culture & Recreation Department**

- Previous experience in park maintenance and grounds keeping is desirable.
- Knowledge of turf care, plant materials, and tree care.

**Public Works Department**

- Must be 18 years of age by date of application.
- High school diploma or GED; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Previous experience in construction, utilities and/or street maintenance is desirable.

**WORK ENVIRONMENT:**

The physical demands and characteristics of the work environment described here are representative of those occurring in the performance of the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the essential functions of this job, the employee is frequently required to stand, walk, sit, kneel, bend, or climb; and to use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools or controls; and talk or hear. The employee must be able to lift up to 25 pounds on a frequent basis; lift 25 to 50 pounds on an occasional basis; and lift and or move 50 to 100 pounds with assistance. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

This position regularly works outside in various weather conditions. The employee frequently works near moving mechanical parts and is frequently exposed to vibration. The employee may be exposed to physical hazards from mechanical and electrical equipment and also will sometimes work in hazardous areas under hazardous conditions. The employee occasionally works in traffic and in high, precarious places and is occasionally exposed to fumes or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals, and the risk of electrical shock and radiation. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate to loud.
