

Organizers Wanted – Drivers Union

Drivers Union is a worker organization representing gig workers in Washington State, primarily Uber and Lyft drivers. For years gig workers have had their rights and their input into their working lives restricted. Drivers Union is one of the first organizations in the nation to provide a legislative and legal framework for drivers to have a true and legitimate voice in their work lives. Drivers have fought long and hard to establish these rights and are looking for staff who are committed to fight for social and economic justice for their communities.

Drivers Union staff perform a wide range of duties. This role will require:

- Ability to reach workers through various outreach methods including visiting work locations and homes, social media, and other forms of communication
- Identifying and developing worker leaders, building strong relationships, and developing and leading one-on-one and group trainings
- Developing and executing campaign strategies for education and outreach as well as for systemic improvements and policy changes
- Ability to understand and help others understand local, state, and federal laws and rights that impact drivers, including Seattle's labor standards
- Working well within a team, and willingness to work long and irregular hours
- Maintaining records and databases, and proficiency in workplace applications especially Zoom, Teams, Word, Excel, and Outlook
- Valid driver's license, auto insurance and car
- Other duties, responsibilities, and activities that may change at any time

Drivers Union offers a competitive salary and excellent benefits including full family medical, dental and vision, auto allowance, paid time off, retirement, etc.

Particular consideration will be given to candidates with for-hire driving experience, fluency in language(s) other than English, and community leadership in the region's diverse immigrant and refugee communities. Applicants will be considered regardless of race, color, creed, national origin, ancestry, sex, marital status, disability, religious or political affiliation, age, sexual orientation, or gender identity. Drivers Union encourages people of all backgrounds to apply.
