The International Union is holding a strike authorization vote by electronic balloting. A YES vote will give our union more leverage at the bargaining table.

Voting Yes will also send a message that members will not accept givebacks or a weak contract.

A YES vote does not mean there will be a strike. We will have the opportunity to vote on a contract offer from the company before the contract expires on July 31.

A strike vote packet has been mailed to you.

Vote YES to tell UPS that we will not accept givebacks or a weak contract.

How the Electronic Strike Vote Works

A strike authorization ballot packet was mailed to every UPS Teamster on May 15.

The strike authorization vote is being done electronically.

You were mailed a unique access code cast your ballot by phone or on the internet. No one will know how you voted.

If you do not receive your voting code by May 21, call your local union to request a replacement packet.

The deadline for voting is 8 p.m. on June 3. The vote count will be on June 5 so the union is armed with more leverage when negotiations are held on June 6.
