

To: Local Unions with YRC Worldwide Employees

We have received numerous inquiries from our participants and affected local unions regarding the situation with YRC Worldwide ("YRC") as described in the attached memorandum from the President of YRC. Due to the financial difficulties experienced by the company we have previously agreed to defer the January, 2009 health and welfare and pension payments to a later date. We are encouraged that the company has now stated it intends to resume timely contributions to the Health and Welfare Fund, as required by the collective bargaining agreement. However, in the event the March, 2009 contributions are not received by April 15, 2009, health and welfare coverage will be suspended on April 20, 2009. Notice to the members will be sent on April 16, 2009. We are currently negotiating with the company regarding their request that YRC be permitted to defer further pension contributions, however no agreement has been reached at this time.
