As you are well aware YRC, Inc. an employer signatory to the National Master Freight Agreement has failed to make the Pension contributions owed under the contract for the last two (2) months to the Central PA Teamsters Pension Fund on behalf of our members employed at YRC and New Penn Express.

Our members have already given enough through the ten percent (10%) wage reduction and should not suffer any more losses due to the company's own poor management.

Recently the Central PA Pension Fund sent the participants of the fund employed at YRC and New Penn Express a notice that their Accrual Benefits would be frozen until such time as they receive the contributions owed. This is further economic loss for our members.


We have notified the Central PA Pension Fund on behalf of our members that we do not agree with their decision to take such actions.

We write to you on behalf of our members and would request that the International Brotherhood of Teamsters do whatever is necessary to reinstate the accruals that the members deserve and are owed. Further we ask you to take whatever actions are necessary in order to have the Pension contributions paid immediately.

We had been informed that the reason for the Company not making the contributions was the obligation that they had to meet in the second quarter under the covenants. Recently the Company has announced that they received relief on those obligations and therefore the Pension payments should be made.

We thank you for your immediate attention on this matter and stand ready to assist you in anyway necessary to ensure this matter is resolved for our members.

Please be advised that Teamsters Local Union 776 is in disagreement with your recent decision to freeze the Accrual of Pension Benefits for the participants in the Pension Fund employed at YRC and New Penn Express.

As you know, there are ongoing negotiations with representatives from the IBT which could secure the payment of the contributions owed.

We have been informed that the Fund had started the procedure under the funds rules for delinquent accounts in order to collect the contributions owed. We expect the Trustee's to actively pursue all legal avenues to remedy this situation.

The Local Union is ready and willing to take whatever actions are necessary through all legal means to ensure that our member's accruals are reinstated.

Please respond to me in a timely fashion as to what your intentions are so that we can inform our members on what course of action needs to be taken.




