Hoffa and Ken Hall are trying to scare members into accepting a weak contract by threatening to hold a strike vote.

Local 710 Teamsters in Indiana and Illinois Voted No by 73% to reject their contract. The Local 710 ballot said it was a strike authorization vote. But there will not be any strike. Why?

Because just like here, the “strike vote” was only a scare tactic to try to get members to accept a bad offer.

UPS wants no part of a strike, or even talk of a strike in the media, especially after the terrible press the company got at Christmas.

UPS has a national delivery network and they would be crippled without the operations in the areas that don't have a contract yet,

including Western PA, the Philly Airport and the Louisville Worldport Hub.

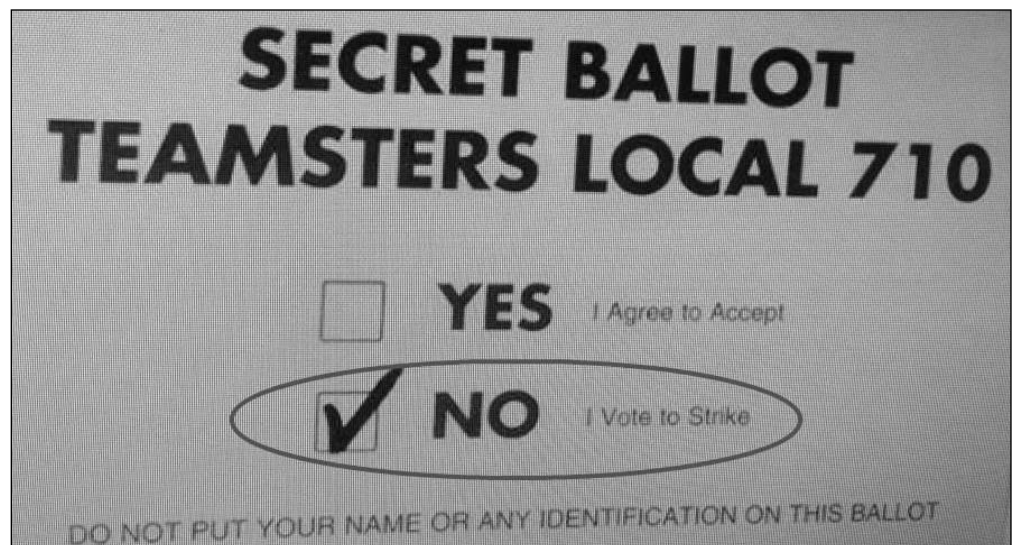
This gives our union leverage. But instead of using a strike threat against the company, they turn it around and try to scare the members. Don't fall for it.
