
Your recent California Public Records Act Request to Solano County Sheriff Tom Ferrara, received August 1, 2016, was forwarded to me for response.

Pursuant to CA Government Code section 6253(c), this is to notify you that it is necessary to extend by an additional fourteen days the ten-day limit for determining whether your request seeks copies of disclosable public records for the following possible reasons:

- The need to search for and collect the requested records from field facilities or other establishments that are separate from the office processing the request.
- The need to search for, collect, and appropriately examine a voluminous amount of separate and distinct records that are demanded in a single request.
- The need for consultation, which shall be conducted with all practicable speed, with another agency having substantial interest in the determination of the request or among two or more components of the agency having substantial subject matter interest therein.
- The need to compile data, to write programming language or a computer program, or to construct a computer report to extract data.

Accordingly, we will notify you of our initial determination no later than August 24, 2016, 2016. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.
