Pursuant to Government Code section 6253, this email is to inform you that we have determined that your request, in part, seeks copies of disclosable public records in the possession of the County, and that the County intends to provide records responsive to your request, except for records retained by the County that are exempt from disclosure by express provisions of law, including, without limitation, preliminary drafts and notes pursuant to Government Code section 6254 (a), attorney-client communication pursuant to Government Code section 6254 (k) and Evidence Code section 1040, corporate financial and proprietary information and trade secrets pursuant to Government Code sections 6254 (k), 6254.15, 6255, and Evidence Code sections 1040 and 1060. In addition, or alternatively, and without limitation, such records may also be exempt from disclosure as such a time consuming, overly burdensome, and costly review which your request would compel the Department to undertake, of a voluminous amount of records makes the public interest of nondisclosure outweigh the public interest of disclosure. Said exemption is within the meaning of California Government Code 6255 and the holding in the case of American Civil Liberties Union Foundation v. Deukmejian (1982) 32 Cal 3d 440.

Pursuant to your request, the appropriate records are being assembled and will be provided at a later date. Please note that we anticipate the costs allowed to be recovered under the Public Records Act will significantly exceed the \$100.00 limit indicated in your letter.
