**Dirt Club (grades K - 2)**

**Ages:** Open to K - 2nd Graders.

**Times:** Program will run from 1:30 - 3pm on Mondays (Early Release).

**Dates:** April 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, May 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>

**Cost:** \$60 for 6 weeks and is limited to 15 students.



**Garden Team (grades 3 - 5)**

Focused on hands-on gardening skills.

**Ages:** Open to 3rd - 5th Graders.

**Times:** Program will run from 3 - 4:30pm on Wednesdays.

**Dates:** April 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, May 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>

**Cost:** \$60 for 6 weeks and is limited to 15 students.

Unlimited scholarships available.

Students will **meet in the Learning Preserve** at 1:30pm on Mondays (Dirt Club, grades K - 2) and 3pm on Wednesdays (Garden Team, grades 3 - 5).

Parent **pick up in front of the school on 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue** at 3pm on Mondays (Dirt Club, grades K - 2) and 4:30pm on Wednesdays (Garden Team, grades 3 - 5).

A healthy snack will be provided each afternoon.
