Homelessness, affordable housing and prioritizing human powered transportation.

I am counting on the CoH ballot measure to win, while I am campaigning I will also be promoting that gross receipts tax. If it passes we will have a revenue stream and a strong mandate from voters to build shelter and housing, and to invest in homelessness prevention.

I will propose an affordable housing overlay for the 80% of SF that is zoned too low density for affordable housing to be built. In combination with the recent DR reforms, this will unlock many acres of land for subsidized housing.

For narrowing streets and widening sidewalks, I will have regular visioning events culminating in several pilots that will be deployed at the end of the summer every year (when everyone is at burning man :). The idea is to get people attached to the low-car capacity version of the street.
