Defending civil liberties and aggressively checking executive power Reducing military spending to save and secure vital social services Ending the war on drugs to dismantle the prison-industrial-slavery complex

Challenging corporate corruption in Washington is a theme pervading these discrete goals.

I will aggressively champion civil liberties through both oversight (I will seek seats on the Judiciary and Intelligence committees, offering opportunities to investigate federal agencies including FBI, NSA, and CIA) and legislation (to reform the bloated and dysfunctional classification system, and by seeking a judicial warrant requirement for any searches implicating Americans).

Similarly, I will seek reductions in military spending both through oversight (I also hope to gain a seat on the House Appropriations committee) and also legislation. I'll build support among progressive Democrats and a transpartisan alliance with libertarians who also favor closing U.S. military bases in foreign countries, which could save hundreds of billions of dollars every year to instead secure vital social services including student debt relief, early childhood development, affordable housing, and VA benefits.

San Francisco suffers a continued affordability and housing crisis. Please explain how you think this crisis should be addressed (in general), then list actionable concrete steps you would take, if elected, to move toward those solutions. Include an explanation of whose interests you will prioritize, and at least one example of a step you would support but which is not currently politically feasible.

First, with respect to the question about vacancy controls, I can't commit to implementing them because the seat for which I'm running has no authority over that issue. That aside...

One aspect of our housing crisis relates to homelessness, which particularly strikes veterans. My proposal to redirect spending from corporate weapons systems to VA benefits aims in part to get every vet a roof over his or her head. I'll build the case for that shift in spending priorities by seeking support—with groups representing homeless vets—from less progressive communities who claim to "support our troops."

Another aspect of the urban housing crisis relates to new building construction, and the extent to which it includes affordable units vs. market rate units. Another of the spending priorities to which I hope to direct cost savings from addressing fraud, waste, and abuse in corporate military contracting is HUD community development block grants, which can help states and cities incentive the construction of affordable housing.

I will prioritize working Americans over the interests of corporations. A feasible beach head for my plans is the closure of some U.S. military bases in foreign countries, which often undermine national security by antagonizing foreign populations, and which many fiscal conservatives would support. The elimination of particular fraudulent weapons systems (like the F-35, representing a potential cost savings in the trillions of dollars) may be more of a stretch goal given the co-optation of some parts of labor by the military-industrial complex.

With respect to the question about CleanPowerSF, I don't own the home in which I live and have suggested to my housemates that we shift to the 100% renewable plan.

With respect to the question about tasers, they are profoundly problematic and only less lethal than guns (not entirely non-lethal). In Miami, police were found to use tasers as extrajudicial means of meting out random punishment without trial, and after Oscar Grant was killed by BART police, the officer who did it claimed (however absurdly) that he confused his taser with his gun, suggesting that the former is not necessarily poised to reduce uses of the latter.

I know the League relies on candidate statements to differentiate among the candidates, but would be eager to meet and if possible address the group to make clear why I'm the strongest choice among the competing candidates to beat Pelosi and get SF real progressive representation in Congress.
