



Where?




The march starts at the top of Gower Street where it meets Euston Road.



The nearest tube stations are Euston Square and Warren Street.

They do not have step-free access. **The nearest station with step-free access is King's Cross-St Pancras.**



A bloc is a group of people who choose to march together. There is a bloc organised by Deaf and Disabled people.

You can join them if you want to.



If you need help working out how to get there you can phone the numbers on the bottom of this leaflet.




There will be coaches organised from other parts of the country.

For people who don't want to march the whole way there will be a shorter march.


People will meet outside the Hippodrome on Charing Cross Road from 2pm. They will join the rest of the march when it goes past.
