Legislative Proposal, Bill or Resolution

- Amend Omnibus Budget Bill to ensure no government control over content in CBC
- Amend the Fair Elections Act to ensure Vouching and the Voter Information Card are accepted at polling booths as forms of ID and to give the Commissioner of Canada Elections the power to compel testimony from witnesses in cases of fraud

- Begin a comprehensive, independent safety review of all hydrocarbon transportation – pipelines, rail, tanker and truck – including public hearings and an examination of the role of deregulation and privatization in reducing safety standards.
- Implement an immediate ban on shipping oil in the older, type 111A tanker cars and reinstate mandatory two-person minimum train crews;
- Not to sign the Canada China Foreign Investment Protection and Promotion Act into law
