The Eagle represents vision, strength, leadership and guidance for all First Nations and is the messenger to the Creator. The Eagle is embracing a union of Nations represented by the four colours (red, black, yellow & white) of man. The original people in red are embraced and represented by the eagle and its eagle feathers, a tradition of centuries. The symbol of man, the inukshuk, represents the Inuit people of the north and as a collective are moving in the right direction. The infinity symbol highlighted on the Metis sash represents the coming together of two strong vibrant cultures and a union that will exist forever. The lightning bolt represents positive energy between all the Nations living and working together in balance and harmony on Mother Earth.
