Industrial tax exemptions are allowed under Louisiana law as incentives to spur economic development that would not otherwise have happened.

Calumet Lubricants & Waxes LLC is requesting property tax exemptions for plant upgrades totaling \$38.9 million.

If approved, these exemptions would cost Caddo Parish \$5.8 in lost revenue over the next 8 years.

- Caddo Sheriff would lose \$488,284
- City of Shreveport would lose \$1.65 million
- Caddo Parish government would lose \$949,462

Blackwell Opinion

"The constitutional question is whether the retroactive grant of an ITEP exemption for a project that has already been completed provides an 'incentive' or 'inducement' for the completion of the project. The obvious and foregone conclusion is that it does not.

"It is our considered opinion that that the retroactive grant of an ITEP exemption for a project that has already been completed violates the purpose of Industrial Tax Exemption Program and such an approval would likely be deemed unconstitutional."
