- Spruce Tree (more than 3 feet across)
- Bald Eagle
- Pod of Orcas
- Whales Bubble Feeding
- A waterfall
- Sea otters
- Fishing boat
- King/Chinook salmon
- Chum salmon
- Sockeye salmon
- Someone fishing on a river
- Someone fishing on a boat

Notification must be made by 11:59 pm AKDT August 31, 2018. This is a separate drawing from the Southeast Places scavenger hunt. One entry allowed per scavenger hunt (you may apply once for each contest).

Eligibility

SEACC's Tongass Imprints Scavenger Hunts are open to all professional and armature photographers. Board Members and Employees or their immediate family (partners or family living with them) are not eligible to enter.

By submitting an entry to SEACC through the Water Reporter app, entrants certify that their participation in this contest is not illegal or in violation of any law, regulation, treaty, or administrative act.

The following submissions are ineligible:

- Photos of captive animals photographed in zoos or commercial game farms.*
- Photos that violate or infringe upon another person's rights, including but not limited to copyright and photographs of persons without the necessary consent required by law. SEACC reserves the right to require entrants to submit evidence of the subject's legal consent to be photographed for the submitted photo which could include a waiver.*
- Images that involve the willful harassment of wildlife, or damage to the environment by the photographer.*
- Images that involve putting any individual or animal in danger.*

SEACC reserves the right to exclude and delete any photos deemed inappropriate or sensitive in nature.
