Over \$7.2 million secured for the improvement of parks in our district. Highlights include:

- \$16.1 million for Honolulu Zoo enhancements
- \$10.2 million for Ala Moana Regional Park improvements
- \$5.1 million for the Hanauma Bay Nature Preserve
- \$3 million for Koko Head District Park improvements
- \$1.3 million for Sandy Beach Park improvements

Seven Bills Signed into Law

Seven bills that I introduced were adopted by the Honolulu City Council and signed into law. Highlights include:

- Bill 10, enabling car sharing in Honolulu
- Bill 45, installation of baby diaper-changing accommodations
- Bill 66, providing real property tax exemptions
