Located along the **Thames River** and historic **Talbot Trail**.

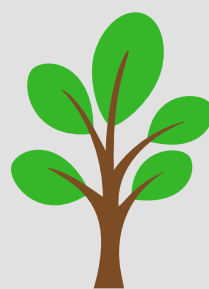
