## **Attention Local 234 Members Employed by SEPTA, *Your Voter Card is in the Mail***

Local 234 members employed by SEPTA can no longer vote in a union election with a regular ballot by getting their SEPTA pass punched at the polling place. The new SEPTA pass, which most of us now have, cannot be punched to show that you already voted. This creates a problem of election integrity, given the large number of Local 234 members who can vote at more than one location, such as floaters, cashiers and maintenance custodians.

The Election Committee has decided to address the problem by providing you with a special, Union issued **voter card**, something similar to a voter registration card.

You will need the voter card to vote a regular ballot on Election Day. The voter card has your name and account number. When you go to vote, you simply show your SEPTA pass and turn in your voter card to the representative of the American Arbitration Association, the neutral organization conducting the vote.

If you are eligible to vote at more than one location, you follow the same procedure, you simply show your SEPTA pass and turn in your voter card. If you don't have your voter card you can vote a challenged ballot, by showing your SEPTA pass.

If you received the Notice of Nominations in the mail you should receive your voter card with no problem. If you don't receive your voter card by Thursday, September 15, 2016 call the Election Committee at the Union Hall, 215-972-4140, for a replacement.
