MICHAEL J. QUILL & PA AFL-CIO SCHOLARSHIPS

NOW OPEN FOR APPLICATION

TWU family members graduating from high school or attending an accredited post-secondary institution are eligible to receive two different scholarships; one funded by the International Union, the Michael J. Quill scholarship; the other sponsored by the PA AFL-CIO.

Michael J. Quill Scholarships

The TWU has been honoring our founder, Michael J. Quill, with scholarships since 1969. The Quill scholarship offers fifteen (15) **college-bound dependents** of TWU members with a scholarship worth \$4,800.00. The scholarship will be paid out, per year in the amount of \$1,200.00 to winners who continue to be eligible over their four (4) year course.

Applications are now being accepted for the 2020 Michael J. Quill Scholarship. **The deadline for all applications will be April 24, 2020; no applications postmarked after this date will be accepted. No applications will be accepted by fax or email – there will be no exceptions.** Winners of the scholarships will be determined by a public drawing, to be held in May. Winners will be notified by mail 5 – 7 days thereafter.

The PA AFL-CIO is offering three scholarships to the winners of an essay contest focusing on two categories of importance to the labor movement.
