

Independent Centre for the Resolution of Specific Claims – Draft Review Process and Next Steps

Review and next steps shared by AFN (CCoLTR has been briefed)

- 1) AFN to release proposal for public comment (May/June)
- 2) Finalize public comment period (July/august)
- 3) Develop joint AFN – Canada protocol to develop detailed costing and proposed machinery/legislative changes for inclusion in future Memorandum to Cabinet
 - a. Consideration:
 - i. TOR – require clear definition of co-development and how to address impasse through political direction
 - ii. In the event of fundamental impasse seek political direction from Chiefs-in-Assembly
- 4) Cabinet decision (2021-22?)
 - a. If successful final joint outcome goes to Chiefs-in-Assembly for approval
 - b. If unsuccessful seek political direction re: next steps

- 2) Federal Election
- 3) UND Action Plan / Engagement
