**Re: 2021/2022 BC First Nations Gaming Revenues Funds Distribution Summary**

Dear Leadership,

We are pleased to advise that on April 28, 2021 the BC First Nations Gaming Revenue Sharing LP received a total of \$56,421,002.00 in Provincial gaming revenue for 2021/2022 (the “**Year 3 Funds**”). Year 3 Funds were expedited on May 10, 2021 ahead of the May 31, 2021 deadline, and were distributed and allocated as follows:

- \$46,091,286.13 has been distributed to eligible, compliant Limited Partners.
- \$7,805,932.50 is currently held in the partnership trust account for 33 Limited Partner as a result of non-compliance.
- \$2,523,783.37 is currently held for four Limited Partners who remain unsigned with BCFN Gaming Revenue Sharing LP.
- The average 2021/2022 allocation to BC First Nations was \$280,701.50.

We look forward on continuing to work together in support of benefiting BC First Nations.
