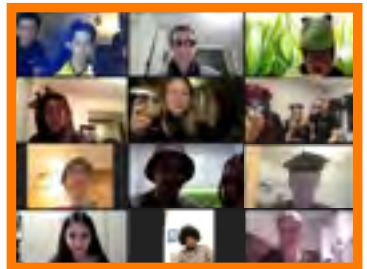

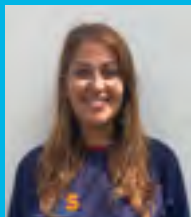

MASA INTERNSHIPS

Masa has partnered with over 600 leading Israeli companies and government organizations that offer highly-coveted, exclusive internship positions. Fellows live in Israel **for 4-6 months** and gain valuable interning experience that's directly relevant to their industry.

Who Can Apply?

Students or college graduates (between the ages of 18 and 30) from a variety of fields looking to launch their careers, grow their networks, and have an authentic Israeli experience.

Fellows are not required to have previous experience in their field of choice.

- Costs start at \$5,000*, depending on several factors including the type of program, length of stay, and more.

*Program cost is before grants and scholarships, which can cover a significant part of the cost.

MASATECH

MasaTech is an elite career program that places programmers from around the world with leading, cutting-edge Israeli tech companies, in competitive paid positions.

Fellows live in Israel for **10 months** (with an option to receive a work permit for one year) while gaining valuable tech experience.

Who Can Apply?

Experienced programmers (between the ages of 21 and 40) looking for opportunities in all areas of software development, including front-end, back-end, mobile dev, and more.

- MasaTech is a no-fee program.

MASA REMOTE WORK / MASA REMOTE STUDY

Masa Remote offers opportunities to young adults whose lives have been moved to the remote world.

Masa Remote Work allows young professionals to keep their current jobs and salaries while relocating to Israel for the duration of the program. Fellows have access to a dynamic co-working open space in Tel Aviv and get to network with other young professionals.

Who Can Apply?

Fellows (between the ages of 22-30) must be currently employed and able to work remotely for 4+ months.

Costs start at \$1,780 per month after a Masa scholarship is applied, depending on the length and type of accommodation).

Masa Remote Study allows college or grad students the opportunity to continue their remote studies in Israel for a semester or longer. Fellows have access to a dynamic co-working open space in Tel Aviv where they can study at their convenience with other remote students and young professionals.

Who Can Apply?

Fellows (between the ages of 18-30) must be currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program and are able to continue studies remotely.

* Programs allow Fellows to live like locals and connect with modern Israeli life.

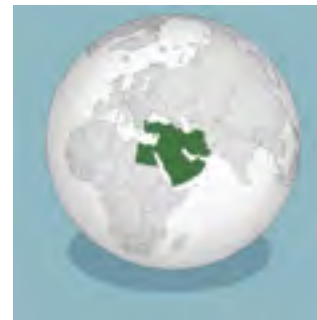

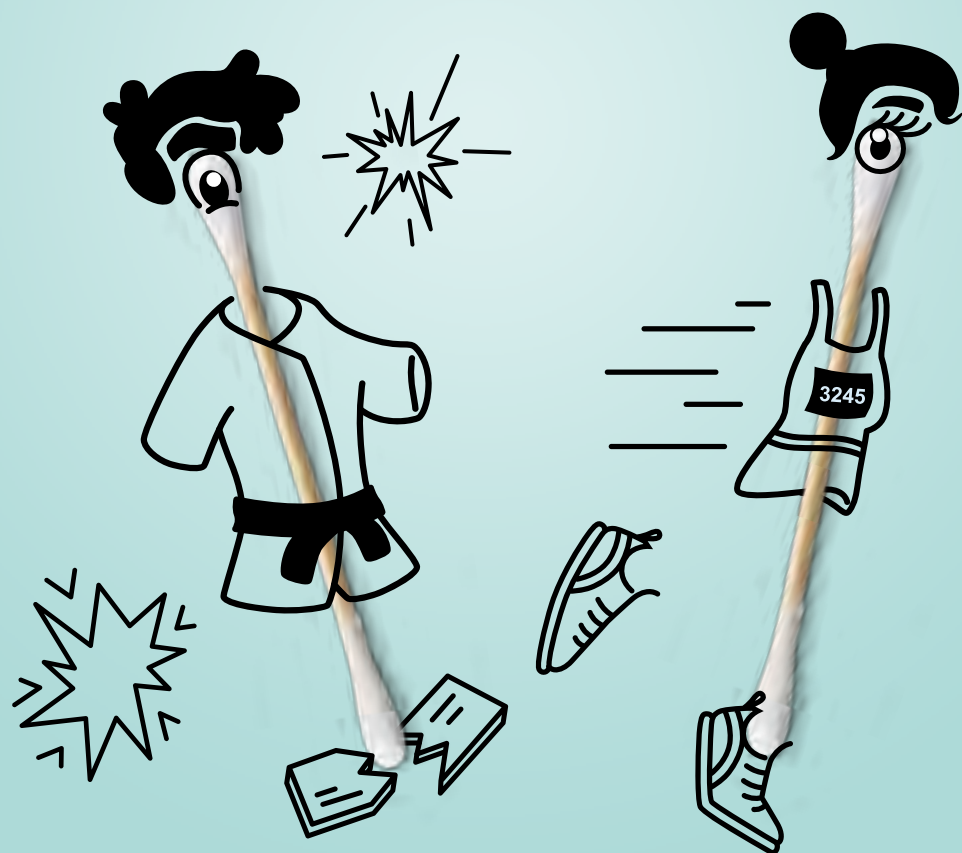

JOIN THE SWAB SQUAD



DO YOU HAVE THE STUFF TO SAVE A LIFE?

TAKE THIS SIMPLE TEST.

If someone has a blood cancer, such as leukaemia, the only chance of saving their life could be a stem cell transplant.

But those stem cells have to come from someone with a matching tissue type, which, if you are Jewish, is far more likely to be from someone who is also Jewish.

Every year, there are over 1,000 Jewish people around the world who need an unrelated stem cell donor to save their life. There is now an urgent need to regularly replenish the stock of Jewish stem cell donors on the national register. There is a particular clinical preference for donors aged between 16-24.

It takes literally a few minutes to be swabbed, and you could make a lifesaving difference if you are a match. Scan the QR Code below to register for your swab kit.

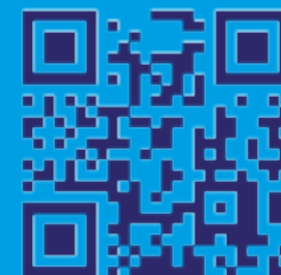

The key to independence

Jewish Blind & Disabled is the only charity in the Jewish community providing independent living for people with a physical disability or impaired vision.

We provide developments of mobility apartments for people aged 18 and over to live independently, in safety with their own front door.

Each of our buildings has its own supportive Jewish community with our house managers being central to the building. Along with providing a 24/7 on call service 365 days a year, house managers keep a caring eye on our tenants.

The majority of our tenants are not born with the disability, instead, at some point in their lives they face a diagnosis that will have a significant impact on their life from that time forward. We know that with the right facilities and support a disability does not have to mean a loss of vital independence and self-worth.

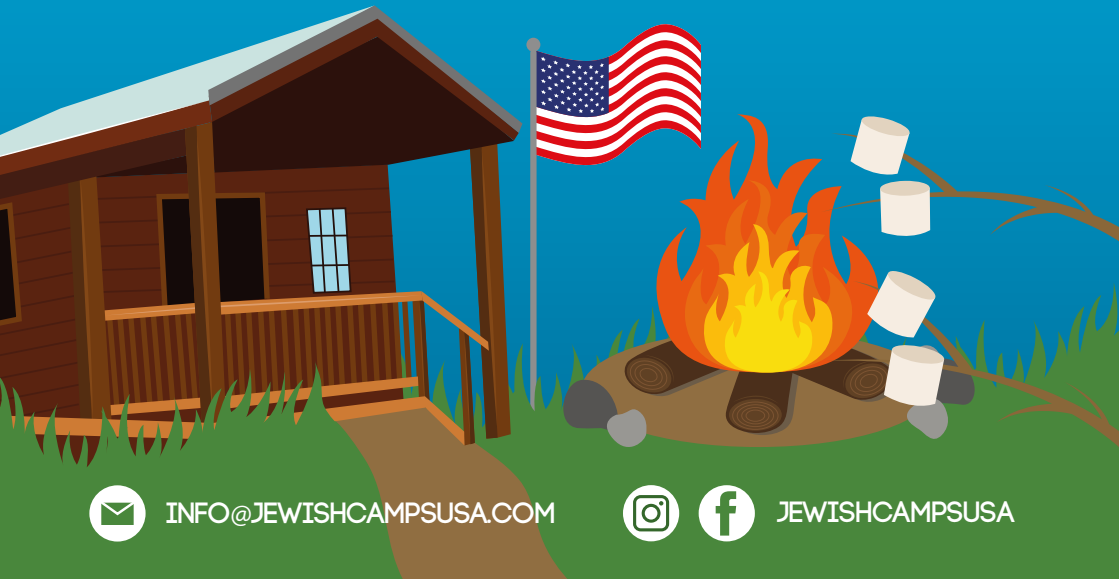
