- Studying first degree
- Self-identify as Jewish
- One-off grant, but individuals can reapply in future years

The Jewish Widows' and Students' Aid Trust

Information on the trust: JWSAT was established in 1959 and has been family run since then. It gives grants to about 30 students each year, helping both undergraduate and postgraduates.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Jewish students up to the age of 30
- Supports undergraduates and postgraduates
- Supports Israeli Students coming to the UK for a Masters or PhD
- One off grant, but individuals can reapply in future years
