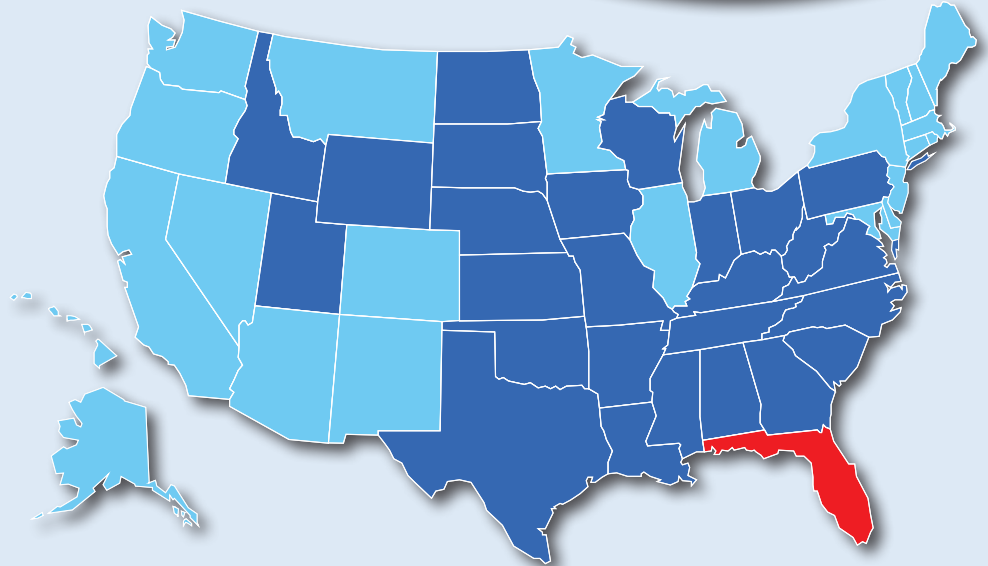

Medical marijuana is now legal in 23 states and the District of Columbia.



About the new petition to get on the 2016 ballot:

- Does NOT permit recreational use.
- Only allows medical marijuana for serious, debilitating conditions such as cancer, ALS, epilepsy, PTSD, and other similarly debilitating conditions and diseases.
- Minors WILL NOT be allowed to obtain without the written permission of a parent/guardian.
- Can ONLY be recommended by a licensed medical physician.
- Medical marijuana will only be able to be obtained through a state licensed and approved location.
- Doctors can be held liable for negligent/improper conduct.
- State MUST set regulations as to who can become a caregiver, including background checks.
