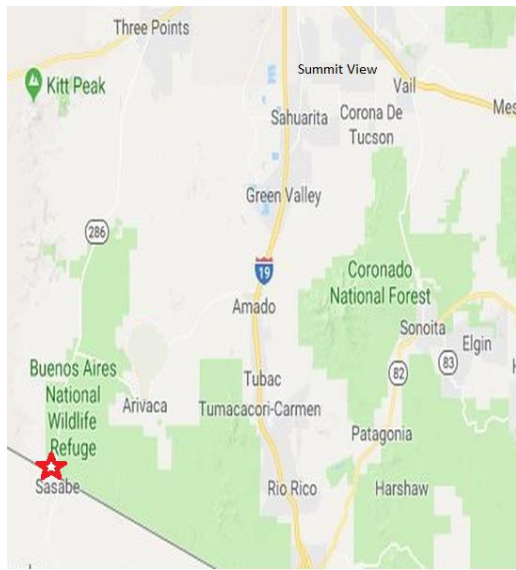

Geographic Information

- Sasabe is a small un-incorporated border community in the Altar Valley of southern Pima County.
- In 2010, the population was 54 residents. Sasabe is much smaller than its sister community, El Sásabe, Sonora.
- Sasabe is best known for its historic Rancho de la Osa Guest Ranch, formerly the headquarters of a three million acre, Spanish land grant. Some ranch buildings reportedly date to the late 17th century. Guests have included President Franklin Roosevelt and President Lyndon Johnson.
