WorkforceReady will offer online courses for participants to develop essential, non-technical skills, including time management, creative problem solving, resume building, communication skill development, professional relationship building and more. After students complete the core curriculum successfully, they will be invited to participate in a Work Readiness Certification assessment, including a mock interview. Those who successfully complete the mock interview will receive a Work Ready Certificate validating their readiness to join the workforce.

While preparations are made to launch the rollout of WorkforceReady, the UNITE-LA Youth Engagement team, in collaboration with partner organizations, will provide virtual platforms as a temporary solution for their upcoming spring job skills workshops and work readiness certifications platforms. The WorkforceReady platform will be a longer term and more permanent solution and provide more extensive, professional development resources in preparing youth for jobs, internships and career planning.
