

SUMMER CHECKLIST FOR GRADUATING SENIORS



Each college will have specific steps for you as you prepare for the fall, but these are a few steps all students can take to advance their college and career success this summer:

- Sign up for [L.A. County's Youth@Work program](#) to gain work experience and earn an income this summer (both virtual and in-person opportunities available). If you live in the City of Los Angeles, register for [HIRE-LA's Youth](#).
- Check out these [Promise Programs](#) if you are attending or thinking about attending a community college in the Los Angeles area.
- Check your college student portal/email frequently (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) for specific updates from your campus.
- Be sure to schedule and attend orientation at your school. During orientation you will learn more about the resources available to students and select your classes.
- Look over your school's fall class schedule to get an idea of which classes will be offered, their designated times and dates and any other important information pertaining to specific courses.
- Make sure you completed and submitted enrollment paperwork applicable to you, such as transcripts, AP scores, the AB 540 Affidavit, immunization records, etc., and paid any outstanding fees.
- Finalize your financial aid package – [check out these tips from L.A. Cash for College](#) to make sure all your information is in order and talk to your college's financial aid office.
- Research and apply for student support programs available at your school, such as Summer Bridge programs, EOP and EOPS for low-income students and CAFYES/Guardian Scholars programs for students who have been involved in foster care.
