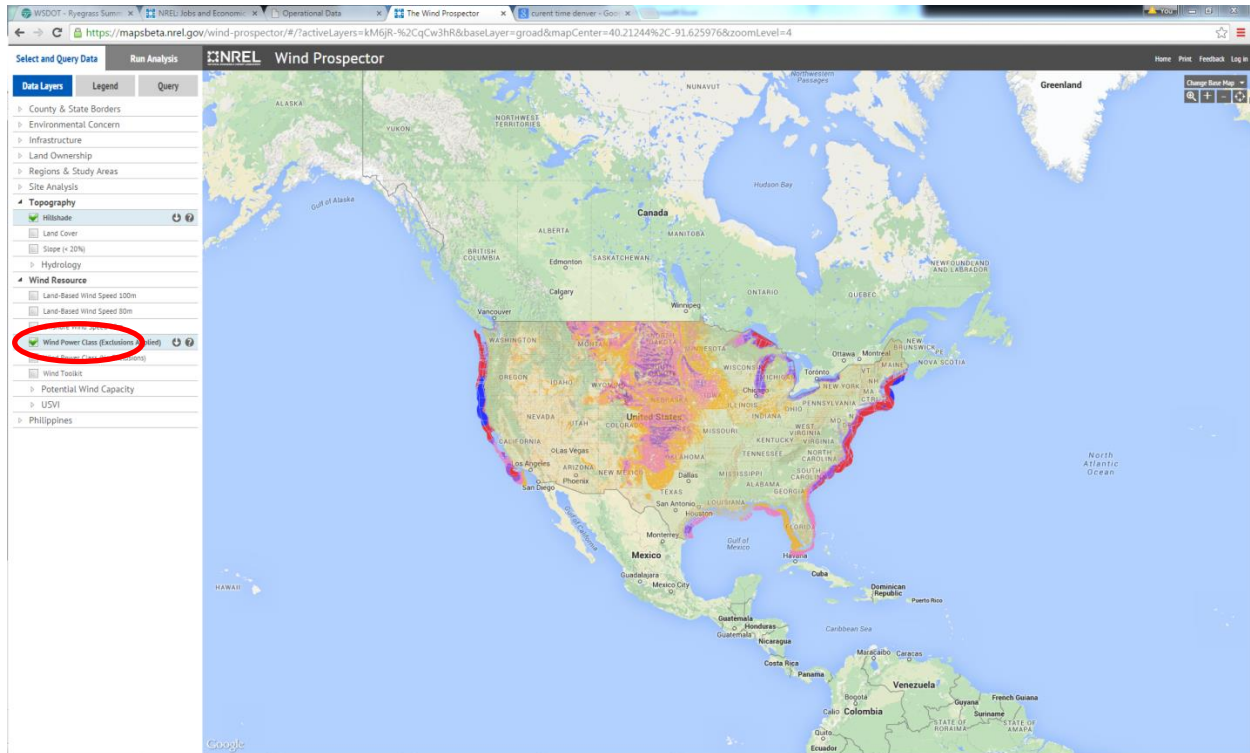


How to download the new Potential Wind Capacity estimates as georeferenced files!

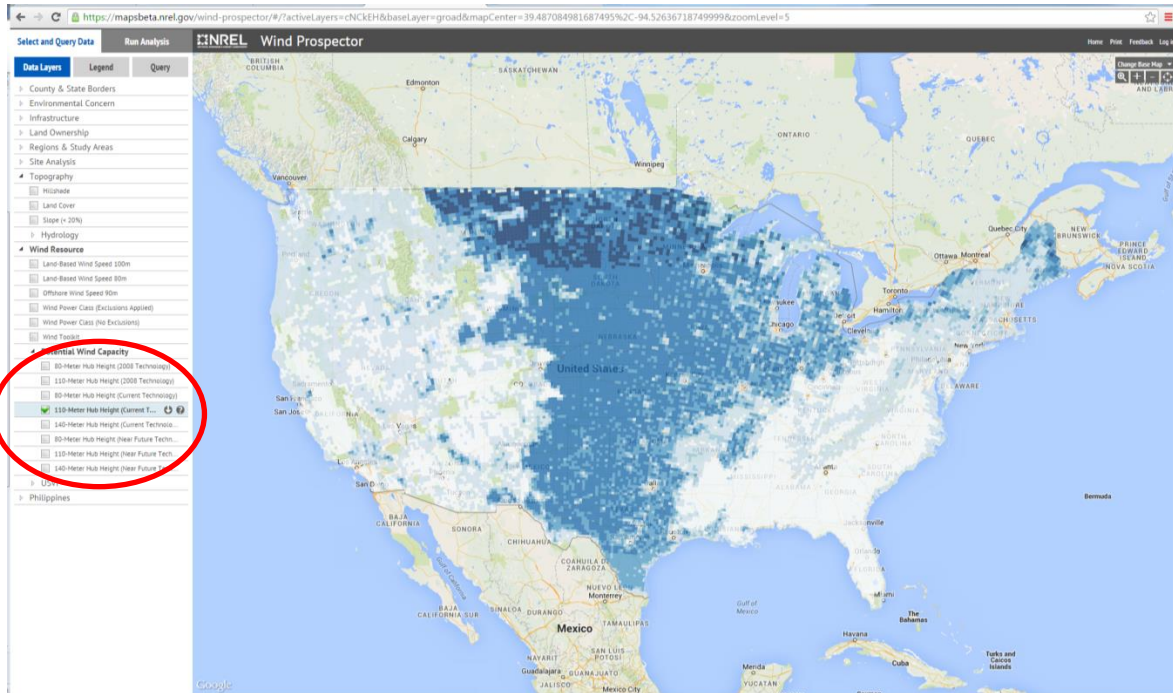
Navigate to the following link

Select “Potential Wind Capacity” from the drop down menu (it also helps to unselect the default “Hillshade” and “Wind Power Class” layers so you can see the data more easily in the future)



Select one layer of data that you wish to download, I believe currently we can only allow one layer at a time.



Click the white arrow pointing downward which will open the download options box. You can download the nation wide data in various forms. The native resolution is roughly 20km square which produces roughly 21,500 points. The file size is roughly 2.5MB for the CSV file.
