WI 7th Congressional District Margaret Engebretson endorsed by Wisconsin AFL-CIO

Balsam Lake, WI – Wisconsin’s 7th Congressional District candidate Margaret Engebretson has been endorsed for U.S. Congress by the Wisconsin State AFL-CIO.

The Wisconsin State AFL-CIO represents about 200,000 union members in the state of Wisconsin and is dedicated to representing the interests of all working people at the state and local level. Nationally, the AFL-CIO (American Federation of Congress and Industrial Organizations) is the largest federation of labor unions in the United States.

Engebretson worked in four professions in which she was a union member: locomotive electrician (International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers); train dispatcher (American Train Dispatchers Union); Deputy Sheriff of Corrections (AFSCME); and postal clerk (American Postal Workers Union).

After her primary victory in mid-August, Engebretson became the Democratic candidate to run against incumbent Sean Duffy in the general election to be held November 6, 2018.

Engebretson also served three years on active duty in the U.S. Navy followed by 21 years in the Naval Reserve and Minnesota Air National Guard.

Engebretson graduated from the University of Wisconsin-Superior and later the University of Wisconsin Law School, after which she focused much of her time on Guardian ad Litem work in Balsam Lake, WI.
