


# When Circulating Nomination Papers...

<p><b>1</b> As a circulator, you will be acknowledging that you personally obtained each signature AND PRINTED NAME and that you watched the people who signed the papers you are submitting.</p>	<p><b>2</b> Make sure that each person fills out the full left side. E-mail and phone number are not mandatory but everything else is.</p>		
<p><b>3</b> Please make sure to the best of your ability that each signer is a state resident. A signer does not have to be a registered voter, but they do have to be eligible to vote in the 7th Congressional District.</p>	<p><b>4</b> <b>Elector signatures and printed names must be legible.</b> If you can't read a name, the Wisconsin Election Commission probably won't be able to either.</p>		
<p><b>6</b> Please check to see that the signer indicates the correct date in the second to last box.</p>	<p><b>7</b> <b>A person may sign only one nomination paper for each office</b> in an election period. Be sure to ask each person whether he/she has signed another person's nomination paper for the same office, before you accept a signature.</p>	<p><b>8</b> Please <b>DO NOT</b> fill out the "Page Number" box - that will be done by the campaign.</p> <p><b>9</b> When you have completed collecting signatures, please <b>RETURN THEM by May 16, 2018 to:</b> <b>Friends of Margaret Engebretson</b> PO Box 93 Superior, WI 54880</p>
