QUESTIONS TO GET TO A GOOD VOTING PLAN.

1. How are you going to vote this year? By mail, in person, early?
2. What day are you going to vote on?
3. Where is your drop box/ early voting location?
4. How are you going to educate yourself on the issues?
5. Are you going to bring anyone to vote with you?
6. What will you do if something happens to your ballot?
7. Do you have an ID to bring with you to vote?
8. Are you prepared to stand in line? What will you bring with you to vote?
9. Do you need to request time off from work to vote?

The key to make a good voting plan is to get the voter to give details that ensure the voter . . .

1. Enables the voter to picture themselves voting
2. Creates accountability for the voter
3. Provides for early troubleshooting and brings out questions that need to be answered
4. Calms any voting anxiety

Remember creating a voting plan is a conversation between you and the voter. The more details the better.

Finally, a voting plan is only good when paired with some social pressure. Here are some good ways to add in social pressure.

1. Thank you for being a reliable voter - you don't want to miss out on voting this year.
2. Your community is having a record turn out - can we count on you to vote?
3. Not who you vote for but if you vote is public record - we are going to be calling our alum after the election to find out about their voting experience.
4. All of your neighbors are voting - can we count on you to vote?
