## Bloor Street West Streetscaping Plan (from Bathurst Street to Madison Avenue)

**Thursday, November 24 from 5:00–8:00pm**  
Markham House – 610 Markham Street



You are invited to join members of the Bloor Annex BIA, Councillor Cressy, and City staff at our 2nd Open House to review the designs for the streetscape improvements and four new parkettes that will be completed in 2018. DTAH landscape architects James Roche, Robin Mosseri and artist Robert Cram will be on hand to walk you through the designs.

The project will include the following:

- Introduction of four new parkettes that will transform former paved surfaces into vibrant green spaces. The designs include seating, large canopy trees, perennial plantings, bike parking, and integrated public art. The four proposed locations include Howland Avenue, Brunswick Avenue, Major Street and Robert Street. The parkettes will be constructed by City-approved contractors and maintained by the Bloor Annex BIA.
- Removal and replacement of 35 raised tree planters with new in-ground trees with increased soil volume to ensure tree health and long term growth and the replacement of existing curb and any damaged sidewalks.
- Installation of additional bike parking and accessibility improvements.
