Background and Proposal

The City of Toronto Planning Division has received an Application for Official Plan and Zoning By-law amendment to modify Pinnacle's approved plans for the south block of the 1-7 Yonge Street development. The existing approvals for this site permit two commercial towers on the south block ranging in height from 22 storeys (92 metres) to 35 storeys (144 metres). This application proposes the introduction of a hotel, an increase in height for both towers, and changes to built form including a PATH bridge connection between the north and south blocks. While the overall heights of buildings are proposed to change, the total of 147,600 square metres of proposed gross floor area is consistent with the existing approvals.


