

Construction Notice

Essential concrete repairs

Bathurst Street between College Street and Bathurst Station

Date: March 14 to 27, 2016

Work description and purpose

TTC will be conducting essential concrete repairs to multiple locations along the track allowance margin on Bathurst Street from north of College Street to Bathurst Station. Repairs at these locations are required to return the track area to a state of good repair.

This work will require streetcar service to be diverted on the **March 19/20 and 26/27 weekends**. Regular streetcar service will be maintained during weekdays.

The repairs will be staged in four phases working north from College Street:

1. North of College Street to south of Ulster Street.
2. North of Ulster Street to south of Harbord Street.
3. North of Harbord Street to north of Lennox Street.
4. North of Bloor Street to Bathurst Station.

Work activities

The track crew will break and remove concrete along the margin of the track area during weekdays. Streetcar service will be maintained.

Concrete placement will follow over the weekend (requiring service adjustments on March 19/20 and 26/27). The newly placed concrete will cure until 5 a.m. on March 21 and 28, before traffic is allowed to travel over the track area.

Traffic and parking details

- To create a safe work zone and maintain through traffic in both directions, street parking will be restricted within the various work zones. Traffic will be maintained in the curb lanes.
- Restrictions will be removed after completion of each phase.

Work hours

Work, including concrete removal and excavation will typically take place from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m., but may extend past 10 p.m. depending on progress and weather. The set up and removal of the work zone is generally conducted during the early morning when traffic is lighter.

TTC service changes (March 19/20 and 26/27 weekends)

- 511 Bathurst streetcars will be diverted to Spadina Station via Bathurst, College and Spadina.
- 511 Bathurst shuttle buses will operate between Bathurst Station and Queen Street (Wolseley Loop).
