

Here's your new **GREEN BIN!**

NEW

Important to know:

- Start using the new bin on your next collection day.
- We will no longer collect from the old Green Bin.
- Removal of your old bin should happen the same day you get your new bin. If you missed this pick up, set your old **EMPTY** Green Bin out at curb on your next collection day. If you miss this second pick up day, then call 311 to arrange removal.
- Do not put yard waste in the Green Bin – yard waste is collected and processed separately.

The way you set your Green Bin out for collection is very important:

- Leave space around all bins and items set out for collection so the truck's automated arms can grab and lift bins.
- With the dial/latch in the locked position, set the bin out for collection with the arrows on top of the lid facing the street.
- The bin must be set out squarely facing the street so the automated collection arms can grip the bin to lift, tilt and empty.

Our collection operation can only work when the bin is set out like this:

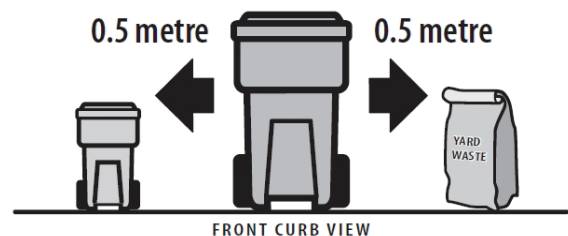
**Arrows on top of lid

The new latch makes the bin easy to use.

- Turn the dial either right or left to the unlock position to open the bin.
- If the dial that locks/unlocks the bin is stiff at first, it will loosen up with use. For quicker results, rotate the dial back and forth several times.
- Place the bin at curbside in the locked position.
- The gravity lock will automatically release when the bin is collected and tilted over the truck.

In addition to food scraps, don't forget to put these organic materials into the Green Bin:

- Diapers, sanitary napkins
- Tissues, paper towels, toilet paper
- Paper ice cream containers



Key Features

- New bins are more animal resistant – bins can be stored outside and set out the night before collection with the lid in locked position.
- No need for overflow bags of organics - this larger bin can hold more organics. It's larger to meet automated collection requirements.
- Keep your new bin clean by washing it out or hosing it down when needed.
