Proposal

In 2015, City Council approved a mixed-use redevelopment at 500 Lake Shore Street West with a 37-storey residential tower, a 41-storey residential tower, a 7-storey commercial building, and a one-storey commercial building under the Gardiner Expressway. Changes to the Official Plan and Zoning By-law are now being proposed to the area under the Gardiner Expressway to reduce the amount of surface parking, improve and add public space, and add 660 square metres of new commercial space in two additional one-storey buildings.

These changes to 500 Lake Shore Boulevard West are being made to improve the relationship of the development to The Bentway, a new public space being created under the Gardiner Expressway, currently under construction.
