

# Construction Notice - Update

## Spadina Station Infrastructure Upgrades

### Lane reductions on Spadina Road north of Bloor Street

**Start Date:** August 17, 2015

**Completion Date:** December 2015

### Update (August 17 to December 2015)

Starting on August 17, the TTC is scheduled to begin **Phase 2** of the concrete repairs, expansion joint repairs, waterproofing and bus roadway repaving at Spadina Station. This work/phase requires lane reductions on the east side of Spadina Road, north of Bloor Street until December 2015. The bus loop will also be closed for work.

**Note:** The majority of work on the west side of Spadina Road (**Phase 1**) also requiring lane reductions (including the sidewalk area) has been rescheduled to take place after the completion of the east side (**Phase 2**). An update notice will be provided prior to the start of west side work.

### Traffic and Pedestrians (August 17 to December 2015)

Work will involve excavating a section of the northbound roadway and the entire bus loop roadway to expose sections of the station roof below and complete repairs.

- Northbound traffic lanes and the Spadina Station bus loop will be closed.
- All traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes to maintain one southbound and one northbound lane through the work zone.
- All sidewalks and station entrances will be open.

### Transit Service (August 17 to December 2015)

- While the Spadina Station bus loop is closed for construction, buses on the **127 Davenport route** will continue to serve all stops on Spadina Road (north of Bloor Street), but will not enter the bus loop.
- After southbound buses serve the station area, they will run south of Bloor Street and loop around Spadina Crescent for the return northbound trip, serving all regular stops north of Bloor Street.
- During construction, customers must board northbound buses on Spadina Road, just north of the station and will need to show Proof-of-Payment. Take a transfer before exiting the station.

### Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. Occasionally, work may be conducted on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
