Dear Neighbour,

As you may already know, a stabbing took place in our community outside of Central Tech high school shortly after 1pm today. While the incident is still under police investigation, I can confirm one student was injured and taken to the hospital.

I am working closely with school trustee, Ausma Malik, and the TDSB to disseminate information and coordinate supports. The City of Toronto's Community Crisis Response Program (CCRP) will be coordinating with the TDSB to provide ongoing support to the school and other affected community members.

Social workers will be at the school tomorrow to support students, faculty, and staff.

I will continue to provide more information on the support protocol as it becomes available.

Incidents like this can be difficult for communities, but I know that our Harbord Village neighbourhood can come together in times like this to support one another. Let's continue our work to keep our community safe and strong.
