

Planning Applications for Honest Ed's and Mirvish Village

The City is holding a Community Consultation meeting where you can learn more about this application, ask questions of City Staff, and share your comments.

Date: Wednesday, October 7, 2015

Time: 4:00pm to 8:00pm (*This is a drop-in meeting. Arrive at your convenience*)

Place: 777 Bloor Street West – Bickford Centre - Cafeteria

The proposed redevelopment includes a number of tall and mid-rise buildings, ranging in height from 29-storeys at the southwest corner of Bathurst Street and Bloor Street West, to 6 and 7 storeys to the south and west, respectively. A number of buildings with heritage character fronting both sides of Markham Street are proposed to be retained. The proposal includes 1,017 rental residential units, 17,555 square metres of commercial space, a 3-level underground parking area, a new publicly accessible market, and the pedestrianization of Markham Street.

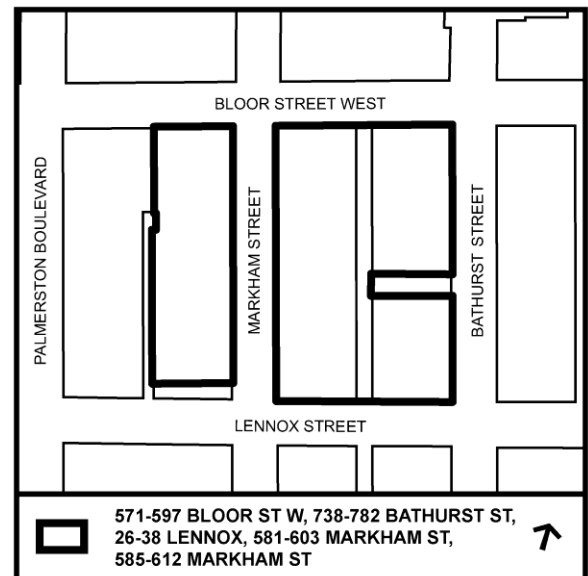
