Line 1 Subway Closure St Clair West to Union stations

Parking restrictions in place to improve transit and traffic on Spadina Road

Dates: February 3 and 4, 2018

Timeline/content accurate at time of printing

Work description and purpose

During the February 3 and 4 weekend, there will be no subway service on Line 1 between St Clair West and Union stations as TTC crews carry out signal upgrades. Shuttle buses will operate – see *Transit service* details below. Regular subway service resumes on Monday, February 5 at 6 a.m.

Line 1 between St Clair West and Union stations is also scheduled for subway weekend closures on March 10/11 and April 21/22, 2018. Visit ttc.ca for up-to-date information on scheduled subway closures.

Parking restrictions on Spadina Road to keep transit and traffic moving

During this subway closure, TTC in co-ordination with Toronto Police Service will temporarily restrict on-street parking on Spadina Road between Bloor Street and Dupont Street to keep transit and vehicular traffic flowing as smoothly as possible for all road users. This approach is vital and is used on shuttle bus routes across the system to keep the city moving during scheduled subway closures.

On-street parking restrictions will be in effect between 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Saturday and 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Sunday.

Transit service

Trains on Line 1 will continue to operate between Finch and Union stations, and between Vaughan Metropolitan Centre and St Clair West stations. Shuttle buses will operate between St Clair West and Spadina stations, stopping at Dupont Station only. There will be no shuttle bus service south of Bloor Street. Customers are encouraged to use the Yonge side of Line 1 to access the downtown core in addition to local routes.

Dupont, Museum, Queen's Park, St Patrick, Osgoode and St Andrew stations will be closed.

Wheel-Trans buses are available for customers who require this service during the closure period. Please speak to any TTC employee or Customer Service Agent to request the service.
