

Transit Notice

Line 1 closed - St George to Lawrence West stations Track improvement and signal upgrades

Date: March 5/6 and March 19/20, 2016

Maintaining subway infrastructure in a state-of-good-repair is critical to ensuring a safe, reliable transit system. While the TTC does much of its maintenance work on the subway at the conclusion of service each night, it will continue to require weekend closures to complete improvements to infrastructure and signals. One weekend of work during a subway closure equals about five weeks of nightly work.

Work description and purpose

On the weekends of March 5/6 and March 19/20, subway service will be suspended between St George and Lawrence West stations as TTC conducts rail replacement and signal upgrades. Regular subway service resumes on the Monday after each weekend at 6 a.m.

Transit service

During these closures, all trains on Line 1 will turn back northbound at Lawrence West Station and southbound at St George Station. A frequent shuttle bus service will operate between St George and Lawrence West stations, **bypassing Eglinton West Station** (see subway map). Customers can transfer between shuttle buses and 32 Eglinton West buses at the intersection of Eglinton Avenue and Bathurst Street. With the exception of Glencairn and Eglinton West stations, all stations will be open for fare media sales.

For customers requiring a station with an elevator, Wheel-Trans buses will operate between St George and Lawrence West stations on request, stopping at all stations except Eglinton West Station. Customers can request the Wheel-Trans bus by speaking with a Supervisor at the station.

Eglinton West Station bus platform closed

The bus platform at Eglinton West Station will also be closed (buses will not enter the station) during the two subway weekend closures to accommodate work related to Metrolinx's Crosstown LRT project.

- **109 Ranees and 63/363 Ossington buses** will not enter Eglinton West Station and will turn back at Oakwood/Eglinton area (see bus map). Customers can transfer to eastbound 32 Eglinton buses at Oakwood Avenue and travel to Bathurst Street to board Line 1 shuttle buses.
- **Note:** 109 Ranees buses will continue to operate through Lawrence West Station where customers can board northbound subway trains.
