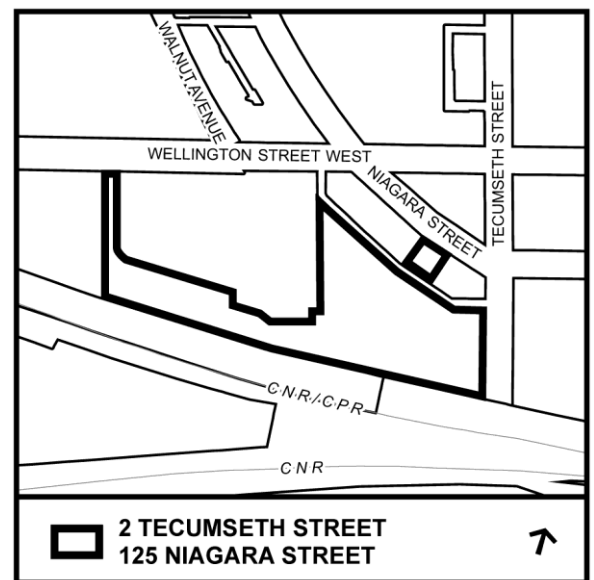

### Community Meeting on Revised Plans

On March 22, 2018, City Planning staff hosted a community meeting on the application to redevelop the former abattoir at 2 Tecumseth Street and 125-133 Niagara Street. The application, submitted by TAS Tecumseth Niagara LP, proposed a 38-storey mixed-use tower, a 15-storey mixed-use building, and an 11-storey office and retail building atop the 2-storey frame of the former abattoir building.

The applications were appealed to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal (LPAT) on March 29, 2018. Since the appeals were filed, City Staff have been working with the applicant on revised plans. At this meeting revised plans will be presented and discussed.

We look forward to sharing our progress and hearing from you on this important development application.
