SUBJECT: Item 10: Fund Balance Report

RECOMMENDATION: That the Watershed Conservation Authority Governing Board receive and file the Fund Balance Report.

BACKGROUND: Attached as Exhibit A is the FY 19/20 Fund Balance Report with balances as of March 31, 2020.

Key changes in the Fund Balance Report are summarized below:

- 1. V52/ Personnel: Increase in fund balance primarily due to reimbursement of indirect costs from Duck Farm Phase 1A Step 2 and Duck Farm House projects.
- 2. V31/ South Gate Operational: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to temporarily transferred funds for labor and other expenditures to various units.
- V38/Duck Farm Phase IA Implementation: Increase in fund balance due to receipt of reimbursement from project management labor and expenditures. However, the reimbursement was partially offset by a reversal of temporarily transferred funds from RMC Subvention.
- 4. V48/South Gate Riparian Implementation: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to construction services from Long Beach Conservation Corp and consulting services from North East Tree.
- 5. V52/Crystal Lake: No significant change in fund balance due to consulting services from BlueGreen Consulting was temporarily covered by RMC Subvention.
- 6. V52/ Duck Farm Phase 1A Step 2: No significant change in fund balance due to receipt of reimbursement from project management labor and expenditures. However, the reimbursement was offset by a reversal of temporarily transferred funds from RMC Subvention and internal transfers of indirect cost and project management labor to V52/ Personnel.
- 7. V52/ Duck Farm House: No significant change in fund balance due to receipt of reimbursement from project management labor and expenditures. However, the reimbursement was offset by a reversal of temporarily transferred funds from RMC Subvention and internal transfers of indirect cost and project management labor to V52/ Personnel.

- 8. V52/ Gateway Greening: No changes in fund balance due to consulting services from Lyric Design & Planning were temporarily covered by RMC Subvention.
- 9. V52/ Vasquez Overlook Acquisition Project: Increase in fund balance due to receipt of refund from Lawyers Title Company for payments related to land acquisition expenditures such as escrow and recording charges.
- 10. V64/Duck Farm Trail Phase 1: Increase in fund balance primarily due to a reversal of temporarily transferred funds for project management related expenditures from V38 Duck Farm Phase 1A Implementation.
- 11. V71/Oaks Improvement-National Forest Foundation: Decrease in fund balance due to consulting services from BlueGreen Consulting.
- 12. V79/ Riparian & Interpretive Duck Farm: Increase in fund balance due to receipt of reimbursement for project management related expenditures.
- 13. V2D/RMC Subvention: Decrease in fund balance primarily due to construction services from Fast-Track Construction Corporation.
