SUBJECT: Item 10: Fund Balance Report

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Watershed Conservation Authority Governing Board receive and file the Fund Balance Report.

**BACKGROUND:** Attached as Exhibit A is the FY 2016/17 Fund Balance Report with balances as of February 28, 2017.

Key changes in the Fund Balance Report are summarized below:

- V19/Duck Farm Operational: Increase primarily due to receipt of a Property Management contribution from the RMC and the replenishment of temporarily transferred funds for labor and other expenditures from various units.
- V20/El Encanto & V72 Walnut Creek Operational: Increase primarily due to receipt of Property Management contributions from the RMC.
- V38/Duck Farm Phase 1A: Increase in fund balance due to an advance from funds to be utilized towards future labor and project expenditures.
- V47/PropADF & V48/PropASGR: Decrease in fund balance due to Project Management labor activity and associated payments for CM services to North East Trees related to design and engineering support.
- V52/Oaks Improvement RLF: Decrease in fund balance due to Project Management labor activity and associated payments to Blue Green Consulting for environmental documents and engineering support.
- V61/Cattle Canyon Improvement & V71/Oaks Improvement NFF: Decrease in fund balance due
  to Project Management labor activity and associated payments to Blue Green Consulting and B &
  E Engineers for CM services related to design and landscape architecture coordination.
- V78/River Wilderness Park Entry: Decrease in fund balance due to Project Management labor activity and associated payments to Ninyo & Moore for permitting and geotechnical services.
- V89/Emerald Necklace Master Plan: Decrease in fund balance due to Project Management labor activity and associated payments to Withers & Sandgren for landscape architectural services.

 Non-material increases in various fund balances are directly related to quarterly accrued interest posted for the months of August through December 2016.
